Historical Society Unveils Plaques

The Temecula Valley Historical Society will meet Friday, September 6, at 1:00pm, in the Conference Room of the Temecula Library. The first four brass plaques that have been prepared for mounting in Old Town Temecula will be shown. These are the first in a series of plaques the Society will provide for residences and businesses. Each plaque denotes the historical significance of the building it will be placed on.

Charlie Dominquez will be invited as guest speaker to present his concept for the interior design of the historic Palomar Hotel, one of the four sites to receive a plaque. A guidebook is planned for the future which will contain the fascinating story or legend of each location.

A status report and update on the buildings comprising the Old Vail Ranch Headquarters will also be presented. Grading has begun for commercial improvements surrounding the site, and the Vail Ranch Restoration Association (VaRRA) will explain what these changes are and the anticipated future plans for the historic site.
